

## Series II [based 1958 onward]



Both wooden toy models are the same size, weight and power and can be made with single or twin drive.

### Differences:

#### SII Cosmetics:

Front apron below grille.  
Sides cover cill area and a 'Round over' swage line full length of body.  
Wheel arches have 'swoopy' L/R style curves.  
Dummy indicator lamps all round.  
Wedge shaped dash panel moulding.  
Instrument panel sticker in SII twin dial style.  
15½" road tread tyres with rounded profile.

## Series I [based 1948 - 1957]



### Cosmetics:

Bumper iron, front cross member and s/handle chassis hole detail below grille.  
Front panel has different shape and larger grille area.  
Wheel arches are half moon shape.  
No dummy indicator lamps in wing fronts.  
Screen folds from different position.  
Body sides finish above chassis to show dummy chassis rails.  
16" Larger wheels with square edged road pattern tyres.  
Oval shape dash moulding.  
Instrument panel sticker shows three dials and switch in SI style.

Sidelights can be mounted in screen panel.

Detail set includes:

Grab handle for dash area,  
Dummy hinges on doors, reinforcing corners,  
starting handle hole escutcheon on bumper.

### SI Building:

Metric measurements on panels  
Part panel set of patterns [sides, inner wings, front panel, cross member etc.] All non square or oblong panels.
